**Ancient Weapons**--How did our distant relatives hunt, protect themselves, and wage war? Students will build a working replica of a catapult or trebuchet, shoot a bow and a slingshot, and have a competition for distance and accuracy.

**Art Through Time**--In this 3-day class, students will learn about different techniques used by artists throughout history, from cave painting to pointillism, from cubism to collage. We'll be exploring many different art mediums, so dress for the mess! Maybe your kid will be the next Monet! This class is \$80/child.

**Bone Up On Bones**—Without our skeletons, we would just be big blobs on the floor! Students will learn many fascinating facts about bones, as well as study creatures with other support systems.

**Build It!**—Looks at the fundamentals of architecture and design, and several building block challenges. How high can they build a tower before it all comes toppling down?

**Block Camp**--If you have a budding builder in your house, this may be the class for them! Depending on their ability level, kids can choose several smaller building block projects (cars, birds, or flowers) or one VERY large project, which they can bring home if they don't finish.

**Can You Dig It?**—The basics of archaeology, including the processes used by real archaeologists to learn about our past.

**Cookin' with the Kids**--Students will learn some basic cooking/baking techniques and make their own treats to take home.

**Crawling Critters**--What lives under logs and in the wildflowers? Bugs, of course! We will go on a bug hunt to identify some insects and other invertebrates, as well as studying them in class through bug bingo and a butterfly life cycle activity.

**Creatures of the Night**--Who's awake while you're asleep? We'll look at the lives of owls, bats, opossums, moths, and other creatures of the night.

**CSI!**-- Learn about how experts work crime scenes, from fingerprints to footprints, and many other techniques.

**Dungeons & Dragons**--Not everyone is into sports, so for those kids who like a little more fantasy in their life, this is a great opportunity to play Dungeons & Dragons with their peers! This class is for kids who have some experience playing already, and will be led by one of our experienced local Dungeon Masters. Every kid gets to take home their own pair of dice! Minimum of 4 kids needed for this class.

**Escape the Room**--Kids will get a chance to try out a family-friendly escape room, and then work together to design one themselves.

**Fossil Frenzy**--What will you unearth during the simulated fossil dig? Learn to be a junior paleontologist and find out about the fossil life found in Mississippi during this unique hands-on class.

**Kitchen Chemistry**—We'll conduct fun (but safe) chemical experiments using common household materials. Discover some basic chemistry facts using vinegar, baking soda, Kool-Aid and much more! Of COURSE things will be exploding!

**Into the Miniverse**--Using miniature fairies, gnomes, animals, and other tiny objects, kids will make their own fantasy world. They may also choose a Halloween theme, making their own haunted graveyard.

**Jewelry-Making**—The fine points of designing and creating your own beautiful jewelry.

**Junior Naturalist**--Students will learn observation techniques, sketching, and identification of plants and animals. They will also make leaf and fish prints, start a nature journal, dissect owl pellets, and go on a field trip to a local nature area. This 2-day class is \$60/child.

**Lake Kayaking**--This outdoor expedition is only for kids ages 12+. We'll explore one of our local oxbow lakes on sit-on-top kayaks with an experienced kayak guide and their assistant. You do NOT need to have any kayaking experience to participate. This class is \$40/child, with a maximum of 4 participants.

**Making Masks**-- The theme of Mardi Gras in New Orleans is "Laissez le bon temps rouler" (let the good times roll)! Now students can make their own Mardi Gras-style masks, among others!

**Mississippi Animals**--What critters live in our state? We'll will have the opportunity to learn about the many different species of animals that live locally, including bears, raccoons, alligators, and much more.

**More Than Mummies**--This fun class examines ancient Egypt, and looks not only at mummies, but also pyramids, deities, pharaohs and the lives of the common people who lived 3500 years ago.

**Mystery Fest 2—The Felix Murder**--This two-day forensic mystery involves observation, problem solving, and detection, as students try their hands at solving a simulated murder mystery. This class is \$55/child.

**Native Americans**-- Native American arts and crafts, games, and weapons! This class may also take a field trip to the Grand Village of the Natchez Indians.

**Nature Crafts**--This entertaining art class focuses on making projects out of common outdoor materials, or things with a natural theme.

**Oh, Yuck!**--To put it bluntly, this is a class about gross stuff--slugs, maggots, yucky smells, scabs, and other things kids love! Lots of disgustingly fun hands-on activities to go with this unusual class.

**Outdoor Survival**—Would you know what to do if you got lost in the woods? Students will learn basic outdoor survival skills, including making fire, devising shelters, finding food, animal tracking and snares, and emergency first aid.

**Oozy Stuff**--Students will use safe household products to explore chemical reactions and make several batches of slimy, oozy stuff to take home! Dress for the mess.

**Printmaking**--Students will make their own artwork to take home, using a variety of printmaking techniques. Dress for the mess.

**Shark Attack!**--Take a closer look at the top predators of the ocean!

**Slimy or Scaly?**--What are the differences between reptiles and amphibians? The kids will find out the answers in this hands-on class with live specimens.

**Soapmaking**--Anyone can buy soap, but it's more fun to make it yourself! Participants will melt and mold their own glycerin soap with special natural additives, colors and scents.

**Spies, Lies, and Bad Guys**--This program is a combination of spy-craft and an escape room experience! Students will learn about some basic techniques that spies use, and utilize their talents to solve a mystery, all while figuring out combinations to locks that will give them more clues.

**What Remains Behind**--After animals have passed by, they leave traces of themselves—tracks, skins, and bones. In this class, students will learn to identify bones, put together a skeleton, and make a plaster animal track cast.
